## **Your Child's Birth Chart**

One of the greatest joys – as well as frustrations – of parenting is that we are quick to learn that children have their own personalities right from the start, bearing no resemblance to their parents or their other siblings. This report will help you learn how to best nurture the unique child in your life.

The Child's Birthchart is a great way for you to better understand the individual personalities of any children you may know. The birthchart is like a road map of all the hidden character traits we possess. Often these traits can lay dormant until they are awoken by a transit from another planet during the course of our lives. While the birthchart remains the same, life is in a constant state of evolution and change. During the youngest years of life, the astrological energies evidenced in the birthchart are at their most pure. Children have the ability to express themselves openly with no self-consciousness and have yet to learn how to control the more difficult aspects of their natures. We must also be aware that children often have needs of which they aren't conscious and can not communicate, so it is up to the parent to be able to pick up on these desires in order to make the child feel loved and safe.

For example, a Cancer Sun child may need a lot of individual attention and affection, while a Leo Sun child is best off being left to explore independently or they will feel stifled; they do require a lot of applause, however.

When reading this report, you may note some of the descriptions seem to contradict each other. We are all complex individuals, and so are our children. It is important to understand and accept their contradictions and allow their personalities to naturally unfold and develop over time.

You may want to keep this report to refer back to as your child ages and new aspects of their personality take shape. This report will also help you pinpoint sectors in which your child will excel and have a natural ability, and how to cultivate these. This report will also help indicate what may be causing more difficult behaviours so you can understand how to better approach and communicate with your child.

When examining the Child's chart it is important to focus mainly on the inner-planets as the slower moving planets (Uranus, Neptune and Pluto) are more generation-defining and these characteristics are more likely to be noted at a later age.

## The Significance of the Sun

The Sun is of particular significance in a child's chart. In astrology, the ascendant is how we appear to others, while the sun represents our true inner nature. As we age, we take on more and more the cloak of our ascendant. It can serve as a mask as well as a shield to protect us from the outside world. The child however is often living in the pure glow of their Sun sign. As they age, you will probably notice them exhibiting more traits of their ascendant. This is completely normal and to be expected and should not be a cause of concern. This is just so you understand why your child is changing.

Young children will express the full intensity of their Sun sign. The Sun sign, as said above, represents our true selves, what makes us tick and true creative potential. By allowing your child to embrace and develop these traits, they will be able to confront the world with confidence and not feel the need to "hide their true selves".

## Sun in Virgo

Mother's Little Helper goes a long way to describing the Virgo child. The young Virgo may seem more like a little adult who thrives in taking on responsibilities, doing chores, and hanging with the grown ups. Your Virgo will blossom when they are given a lot of duties to prove to their parents how accomplished and reliable they are. They will be little work horses who do not have a lot of time for frills and superficial pursuits. You may need to push them a little to take time off and just play. They may seem quite serious and mature for their age. They avoid risk and for the most part are quite respectful and well-behaved. They don't like getting in trouble and will try to go out of their way to please authority figures, be they parents or teachers.

They respect hierarchy and their place in it. The one problem area you may have is that they can be quite bossy to other children and siblings, especially ones younger than they are. Lucy out of the old Charlie Brown cartoons could very likely be a Virgo. Other children may grow to resent their judgemental and critical attitudes. If you have other children, they may feel like they are dealing with an extra parent. Since little Virgos are so good at brown-nosing, hectic parents may unconsciously encourage this behaviour because it alleviates their stress, and the Virgo child is so ready to help out. Parents must be extra aware of the needs of the other children in the environment, and not delegate parenting tasks too much onto the Virgo child, or the other children may suffer. Also, as much as your little Virgo loves helping you out, even they deserve to cut loose sometime. They most likely will never rebel against responsibility so it is up to the parent to make sure they are getting enough free-play time.

Your little Virgo will be quite detail-oriented, tidy and perfectionistic. They are good at duties regarding routine tasks or constructive, pragmatic organisation. When put in a visionary role with no firm boundaries, they may flounder a bit. They may excel at arts-and-crafts projects, where detail and clean-lines are key, as opposed to more creative free-expression. They would grow up to be good designers or graphic artists. They also love taking care of others, and as adults could be attracted to jobs in health care or healing.

Virgos have a tendency to be solitary and shy, and may have a difficult time feeling at ease in large groups. You may want to organise play dates with just one other child, and then once comfortable and confident, increase the number of children slowly so that your child will be able to feel at ease expressing themselves openly in a group dynamic. Virgos put up a facade of total control which hides a more anxious inner nature. They are such perfectionists that they can be quite insecure on the inside. You really need to go out of your way to build the Virgo child's confidence. Unearned flattery will not get you far; you are better delegating chores and allowing them to prove themselves before you start praising them – and when you do it is better not to heap it on thick, but to keep it businesslike and transactional. Action is the best way to build the Virgo sense of competence. They are less likely to spend their time complaining when they realise there are sensible steps to making things better.

Virgo is ruled by Mercury, so your child should have a very strong mind, but they can tend to rationalise things and work best from an intellectual, as opposed to an emotional level. Too much emotion can make them uncomfortable and they can fight back with passive-aggression or judgement. Virgos are great BS detectors and they won't put up with emotional manipulation on any level. If you want something from them, just ask. Honesty and respect, an adult approach, will get you farther.

In school, Virgos pick up things easily and are great autodidacts. If you try too hard to explain things to them, they can take offense and feel patronised. Virgos can be self-punishers and they may work long and extra hard to get things exactly perfect. Again, they will not complain about this, so it is up to the parent to make sure they spend their childhood as a kid and not a mini-adult.

Virgo also rules nutrition and the nervous system. A sensible nutritious diet is very important and if implemented early you may not have to have too many fights over the evils of junk food. They may be picky eaters, but if the food is nutritious you have a better chance of them eating a wide range.

## **The Significance of the Moon**

The Moon represents our emotional response to life. Unlike the Sun, which defines how we leave our mark on the world in an extroverted manner, the Moon represents how the world leaves its mark on us, and how we deal with those impressions. The Moon also represents the Mother and is used by astrologers to understand how the child relates to the nurturing environment of childhood, as well as to women in general. The emotional needs of the child are delineated by the Moon, as well as what can trigger fears or make them feel safe and secure. The parent should pay attention to the Moon to understand how they can interact with their child to raise a healthy, emotionally-balanced adult.

### **Moon in Pisces**

Pisces is the sign of pure feeling. Your child will respond on an extremely emotional level to its environment, picking up on the smallest vibration of harmony or disharmony almost psychically. They may perceive things so strongly on a feeling level that they may have a hard time verbalising or rationalising intellectually what it is they are going through and escape into a kind of dream world. Your child's imagination will be quite strong, but it will be necessary as a parent that you do not let them dwell too far from reality by building up a solid set of boundaries and attainable responsibilities. Your child will respond well to non-verbal communication when it is upset, so give them lots of cuddles, and sometimes just holding them until they work through their feelings will feel best. They may have a tendency towards insecurity, anxiety and co-dependence, so it is important that they always feel safe and that your presence is near. Pisces Moon children can be deeply scarred by criticism, so it is important again that you set attainable responsibilities for the child to build up their sense of personal power. It is up to the adult to act like an adult and watch their words around this child so they don't take something said in the heat of anger to heart. This child will also be very compassionate to those less fortunate and may grow up wanting to save the world. Try to get them involved in volunteer work as this will give them a sense of purpose and they are sure to enjoy helping out.

## **The Significance of Mercury**

Mercury rules the mind and represents the way your child will think and communicate. Mercury can indicate the type of intellectual interests your child will have - for example, if they will be more artistic or technical in their reasoning. It can help you understand in which areas of life your child will have a natural inclination and tendency to excel. It will also give you hints as to how best to communicate with your child and get your point across - for example, some signs are more chatty than others. If your child is having difficulty in school, you may want to further study their Mercury and its aspects.

### **Mercury in Leo**

Your child will like to communicate in big, bold gestures. You may have a little drama king or queen on your hands. They may have a tendency to exaggerate things, but this should not be seen as devious or lying; they just have a tendency to see the world as a stage and all the people, the players. As a parent, your role will be to teach the young Mercury in Leo that somehow ordinary reality is not as beige as it may appear so that they can conceptualise a world on a functional level, warts and all, as opposed to an epic saga. Your child may become bored when things get too mundane and be constantly wanting to make things more magical. Your child will have a strong mind and have no problems speaking its opinion, but they may have a hard time listening. It is important that you teach them to let other children express themselves, and that they have to pass the talking stick once in a while. Excessive flattery could lead to a slight arrogance in your child, while not giving enough encouragement could lead them to be slightly depressed. You will need to give your child a lot of attention without spoiling it.

## **The Significance of Venus**

Venus is the planet of love and signifies how we interrelate with people, our need for harmony and diplomacy, as well as artistic capability. Venus can often point to how much luxury or indulgence we may need - some people are frugal while others like frills and decoration. Venus can point to how we express our generosity to others, as well as how we love. When your child reaches puberty, it would be a good time to look at their Venus to examine how they will interact in romantic partnership, such as their need for independence or co-

dependence, so that you can help them navigate the difficult waters of first love.

## **Venus in Leo**

Your child will have a very big heart, lots of personal charm, and a high level of creativity. Your little Venus in Leo will have no trouble attracting others to them, and they will love the opportunity to be on center stage. Venus rules the arts, and Leo rules creativity, so they will have a tremendous knack for self-expression. Their natural generosity will be limitless and know no strings, however they may get a bit down when they realise that other people have a more Machiavellian approach to generosity. As a parent you may need to keep up their spirits and explain to them about selfish motives and the concept of "give and take" to save your child from being exploited by others. This child may be prone to high dramatics and temper tantrums when things do not go their way, but it is their way of getting attention and they will not bear a grudge. Neither will you, as this child will always be able to charm their way into your heart with their entertaining natures.

## **The Significance of Mars**

Mars represents action, energy and how one expends that energy. By examining Mars we will see what motivates a person, how ambitious they are, and if they have any type of anger issues. Mars represents the drive for success and personal power. This can be important to study so that you can understand what motivates your child, and why they may be lazy or unresponsive. If they have a tendency to rebel, Mars is the planet to look at.

## **Mars in Taurus**

Your child will have a lot of focus, drive and determination. It will not be put off by the concept of hard work and will apply itself to achieve its goals. It may take a while for them to realise what those goals are, however, and during these periods they could be quite idle as they ponder the possibilities of action. They are the types that like to lay the ground work out methodically and will not just jump in head-first to a project or take unnecessary risks. They may have a tendency to caution, but once they make up their mind on what they will do, they will not be derailed. ## **The Significance of Jupiter**

In a child's chart, it can represent the areas in life which pique your child's natural curiosity. It can also indicate where the child may be over-indulgent or try the hardest to get their way. It is important for the parent to allow the explorations of Jupiter without allowing the child too much excess or arrogance.

## **Jupiter in Libra**

Your child will have a great need for harmony and peace, both in their relationships with people as well as the world. They will have a knack, as well, for harmonious self-expression and diplomacy. They are social, with a strong sense of generosity. They may have a tendency towards hedonism and can lose practical focus if they are over-indulged.

## **The Significance of Saturn**

Saturn rules discipline and the father principle. In an adult's chart, astrologers use Saturn to examine the type of relationship a person had with their father and its lingering effects. It also can describe how a child deals with authority in general and the most affective type of discipline to use. All children need structure in order to not be overwhelmed by the innumerable choices in life. Some children however are more independent than others and bristle at too much restriction, while others can feel anxious and fearful when their days are not programmed fully. The position of Saturn in your child's chart can help you to understand how much structure versus free play your child needs and how to maintain a healthy balance between the two.

## **Saturn in Sagittarius**

Saturn is the planet of structure and the status quo, and as such, it is not really at home in the sign of risk and expansion. Your child may be hesitant to try new things or explore new places. Your child may feel overwhelmed by the unlimited possibilities of anything new and have such a highly developed sense of perfectionism and responsibility they may lose all enthusiasm and feel defeated before they even start. Their sense of work and obligation can override the joy of experimentation. You will need to work with them so they can understand the happiness of spontaneous play. Not everything needs to be results-driven.

## **The Significance of the Ascendant**

The ascendant represents the sign that is on the horizon at the time our birth, thusly it defines the first house of the birth chart, the identity sector. The Ascendant describes how we appear to others. We tend to act more like our ascendant as we age. This is why a child who is a bit extroverted can appear more introverted as they grow up (or vice versa). The Sun represents our true identity, while the Ascendant is how we manifest our personality to the world at large.
