## Prologue

Welcome to your Astrology Detective 6-monthlong-term transit report!

First off, please note that all dates are written in the American manner: Month/Day/Year.

A transit happens when a planet directly aligns with a point in your birthchart. Planets also move through the various sectors, or houses, of our birthchart, which is why we go through periods when the focus shifts to a specific area where we are undergoing lots of changes for an extended time.

When reading the report, note that transits from the Sun, Mercury, Venus, Mars and Jupiter are more fleeting and transitory. They are in effect for just a few days or perhaps a week. They help you plan for events or explain a passing mood.

Mercury transits affect intellect and communication, Venus love, socialising and creativity, while Mars rules action, dynamism and risk.

The outer planets of Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and Pluto all take several years to move through one house. Their transits to particular points in our birthchart are long-term and can last for months (or even years off and on), and should be paid particular attention to. They will help you understand complex issues you are undergoing. If in a challenging aspect (square, opposition and sometimes conjunction) this report will help you understand these energies and work with them in a positive way. If in a harmonious aspect (trine, sextile, and sometimes conjunction) please use this powerful vibe to your advantage while you may; it would be a shame to let this help from the universe slip through your fingers.

In the daily reports, you will notice that there is not much day-to-day change in the planets of Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and Pluto. Pay particular attention in this report when you see one of these slow-moving planets shift house, or when a transit aspect starts or stops. These will mark era-defining moments in our lives.

Astrology is not our destiny. As you read this report, you will see the manifestations of different transits can be quite broad, and their affects on us are often largely morphed by our own actions and reactions. Astrology is particularly useful because we can see transits coming in advance and prepare for them, thereby defusing their impact on us. For example, if you are aware that you are undergoing a transit that is affecting your money sector, you will know to be vigilant with spending during a period of specific dates. Sometimes just knowing a date a stressful transit ends can bring a lot of comfort, as you will know for certain that "this too shall pass." We often take good times for granted, and Astrology can make us aware of when we are under the influence of incredible good fortune, so we can go out and make the best use of our luck.

One of the saddest things I have seen in my career as an astrologer are the people that have had a bad experience with an unethical practitioner who filled them with fear and fueled them with ideas that made astrology have a negative and undue influence on their lives. When used properly, astrology can only empower us, because even in bad times, it gives us awareness to garner back some control over events in our lives.

While these reports can give you an in-depth look at the effects of various planetary influences, there is only so far a computer-generated report can go. A computer can not analyze holistically, so if you are undergoing two transits with conflicting energies you may be quite confused. For example, you may be undergoing one transit that says you are having a confidence crisis, while another transit may say you feel great about yourself. In these cases, you need to step back and look at the big picture. Life is complex and we often experience contrasting circumstances and experiences at any given moment. We also can often act in conflicting ways at the same time. If you are undergoing particularly difficult contradictory long-term transits that are causing you much pain, hardship or confusion, you may want to use that time to take the plunge and book a reading with a real astrologer. ## **The meaning of the transiting Sun**

The Sun spends about one month in each sector of the birthchart. During this time, all dealings related to this house are emphasized and highlighted. If you find there is one time of the year when you feel your best, or that you work your hardest it may be because the sun transits roughly the same point in our chart from year to year. The Sun rules identity, life force, self expression, creativity and vitality. The house it is transiting indicates shows where you can shine your brightest that month.

## **The transiting Sun in your ninth house**

When the Sun transits the ninth house, try to be a little adventurous. This is a good time to travel, and even local trips can be quite invigorating. If you can not take a physical trip, a trip of the mind or soul is definitely in order. This is a great time to apply yourself to learning and can be very beneficial to students. Esoteric pursuits are also highlighted. Anything new and out of the ordinary will bring you a lot of joy; you should seek to spend time with foreigners or people outside your culture, who can be help widen your horizons.

During this period you can invigorate your existential view on life and achieve a bit of a personal renaissance, as well as understand and take your proper place in the universe.

## **The meaning of the transiting Mercury**

Mercury rules the intellect as well as communication. It shows us where to focus your mental energies in order to come to effective solutions. If you have long standing issues with people, Mercury's transit will help you sort things out once and for all. If you are undergoing a period of fleeting depression or are temporarily tongue-tied, look to Mercury to discover how long this will last.

In the transit report, look to Mercury to see which days are best for brain work as well as negotiations of all kinds. It will help you time the most effective days to communicate with others to get the results you desire.

It takes Mercury approximately 3-6 weeks to transit a house.

## **Transiting Mercury in your eighth house**

You will be able to connect on an intimate level through verbal communication during this time. Your insights will be quite profound and help you connect to your nearest and dearest, creating a common sense of conspiracy and like-minded purpose. The sense of cosy intimacy you create with your words will make others feel comfortable and secure with you. If you have been growing estranged from your partner, you can confront issues with honesty and integrity which will help rekindle the bond.

You will also have a keen knack for investing during this time. If you have credit or mortgage issues, use this period to get your financial house in order. If you are thinking of applying for a scholarship, grant or loan, do so at this time (check to make sure Mercury is not retrograde, if it is it is better to wait until it goes direct). If you have to negotiate a divorce or pre-nup this would also be a good time.

This period could see you with thoughts that are more intense or deep than usual, but they are also enlightening and can help put you in touch with the cyclical nature and meaning of the universe.

## **Transiting Mercury in Square with your Saturn**

Your words will carry a lot of weight today and you are not up for superficial chitchat. You may also be hyper-aware of the power of your words to the point you don't feel like talking at all.

Your mind may also feel restricted by impositions put on your self-expression by society or the workings of the machine. You may feel like your intellectual freedom is at risk due to cultural impositions, be they social etiquette or workplace rules. You want to communicate heartfelt and naturally but are forced to abide by the script imposed on you.

Saturn can bring a temporary feeling of melancholy or depression. This transit is quite fleeting, however, so try to put off confrontations or negotiations until another day.

## **Transiting Mercury in Sextile with your Uranus**

Sudden changes can put your mind on overdrive. Your mind may be abuzz with nervous energy today, but it can all be quite exciting as opposed to stressful. You may have sudden flashes of insight that will take your thoughts off on an unforeseen tangent. You will be thinking in an original and unique manner and can come to a lot of clever solutions to problems you have at work or in life. You will be quite exciting to talk to today, and interesting and lively conversation abound. Get out and mingle, it can be quite inspiring.

## **The meaning of the transiting Venus**

Venus spends several weeks in each house, bringing a dose of harmony and charm to that sector of your life. Wherever Venus is transiting, you will have an innate magnetism that will win people over. Venus also rules art, luxury, fun and relaxation. Venus can also push you towards lazy hedonism, so it is important you don't let

yourself go too over the top.

Primarily, Venus is the planet of love and will guide how our daily, short-term romantic life. Look to Venus to see which are the best nights to schedule a date, seek someone new or spend a cosy day with your sweetie. Venus transits can be fleeting, so strike while the iron is hot!

## **Transiting Venus in your tenth house**

You will be the king or queen of the workplace during this period. You have a knack for getting people to your side, through your charm more so than anything else. You will be able to be the peacemaker in inter-office politics and this will further improve your standing with your colleagues. This is a time to rule with a velvet glove, and the more harmonious environment you produce the further you will be able to advance your ambitions. This is a great day to schedule a presentation, make a pitch, negotiate a contract, ask for a raise or go on a job interview. You are sure to make a really strong impression. There may even be the opportunity for an inter-office romance at this time.

## **Transiting Venus in Sextile with your Ascendant**

Your easy-going charm will attract others to you. People enjoy being in your company today, both lovers as well as the world at large. If you are single, this is a great day to schedule a date, as you will be quite alluring. If you are in a couple, make sure to schedule time together because your partner is sure to find you irresistible. All this love will make you feel great and confident about yourself. Try to live the day as poetically as you can, and worry about obligations tomorrow.

## **The meaning of the transiting Mars**

Mars is the planet of energy, ambition and leadership. It can also rule war, anger and physical passion. In a healthy dose, Mars can help you achieve your goals and move towards success. Excessively, or in a difficult aspect, you may become a bit egomaniacal and lose the plot.

Mars takes a few months to transit a house, but when it goes retrograde, which happens every two years, it can stay in a chart sector for up to half a year.

Use Mars to understand when are the best times for action and moving towards your goals. You will also see when you may be more aggressive than usual or out to pick a fight. On these days its best to try to chill out and schedule important meetings.

As the planet of passion, look to Mars to see when you are your sexy best.

## **Transiting Mars in your ninth house**

Your sense of adventure is at a high point. This is a great time to cut loose and roam. You will be energised through travel and dealings with new people outside of your everyday circle. If you are a student, or want to go back to school or even tackle a great book, now is the time to do so. You will have the spirit and intellectual curiosity to learn many new things and keep reading til the end. Be spontaneous during these weeks and try not to have your time blocked out with pre-scheduled appointments. If you are involved in litigation, things may start to move forward; you are definitely in a fight-to-win mood. You will be completely reinvigorated by the world if you allow yourself to participate in its wonders. If you want to get something published, try shopping around for an agent these days. Others can look to you for leadership, so try to take the initiative, and you will find many like-minded people who want to come along for the ride.

## **The meaning of the transiting Jupiter**

Jupiter, aka the Gas Giant, is the planet of expansion. It doesn't have its own vibe per se, but instead reinforces and exaggerates what is already going on. Jupiter is often associated with luck, and if you are receiving a harmonious transit from this planet, you may be amazed by your good fortune. For those that are going through a more challenging aspect, Jupiter's force can be overwhelming, razing down long-standing (and usually stagnant) structures overnight. In the long haul, this may seem like luck, because it will help align you to a better path.

Jupiter is the Roman version of Zeus, the chief God and ruler of thunder and lightning. Getting hit by a bolt out of the blue is a good way of understanding this planet's energy. It may very well seem like a bomb has gone off, leaving one a bit giddy and punch drunk amid the mayhem.

Jupiterian energy has a tendency to push us towards excess, and this includes matters of the ego. We need to be careful that we don't get too cocky during our good times, or too judgmental during our bad ones. Jupiter also rules our greater philosophy on life and all things spiritual – the non-material world. During positive transits, it is a good time to expand one's horizons through study, meditation, or travel. Jupiter helps us understand the world and our place in it.

It takes Jupiter about 12 years to make one complete cycle through the zodiac. Because house sizes vary, and due to retrograde motion, Jupiter may remain in one house for up to two years, although if the house is small, it may take less than one. Jupiter transits to planets in the birthchart may just last a few days or a few weeks, but can be quite intense and powerful, nonetheless.

## **Transiting Jupiter in your eleventh house**

When Jupiter is transiting your 11th house, your mind will be focussed on expanding your circle of friends, which you should be able to do with ease. You find a lot of goodwill and companionship in the group dynamic and be able to attract like-minded, interesting people, be they friends or other communal networks. You will have no trouble fitting in (unless there is some challenging aspect going on). Your ability to organise fun and interesting events will make you very popular.

You will find you be able to work towards your goals most effectively collectively within a team. You will find that the people surrounding you will bring a lot of good things into your life. People you meet now will be useful contacts who help you achieve your goals well into the future. This is also a time for no strings attached generosity when you receive just as much as you give.

The eleventh house also rules our ideals and our hopes and dreams. You can be incredibly idealistic at this time and have a very optimistic view on life. You will be able to rally many people to your cause and maybe even make your dreams come true. You want to work tirelessly for the betterment of humanity, and this may be a good time to get involved as a volunteer for a good cause that you truly believe in.

## **The meaning of the transiting Saturn**

Saturn is often seen with fear and loathing in astrology. This is due to the fact that transiting Saturn often brings with it a resulting period of deprivation or hardship in a specific area of our lives. The amazing thing about Saturn, however – and what is often missed – is that it also really forces us to grow up and get our lives sorted and in order. Saturn normally takes about two-to-three years to transit a house in our birthcharts, and during that time we may mature at hyper-warp speed. Saturn likes and rewards hard work. It is all about structure and the building of those structures. The best way to meet Saturn is head-on. When it is transiting a sector of your chart, put all your energies into building a firm basis in that area of your life.

Saturn takes about 27-to-30 years to transit the entire zodiac, so look at each house shift as the start of a 30-year cycle. Saturn will assist you enormously if you do the hard work it asks of you. Often when working towards our goal, results will be delayed until after this transit is over. It is important to keep your eyes on the prize and keep forging on. You may have to deal with limited resources, but the foundation you build will last a lifetime and be almost impossible to topple.

If you do not meet Saturn voluntarily, the universe will force you to and the transition may be a bit more stressful. It is up to you to be the little pig that builds his house out of stone.

There is one transit of Saturn that is especially important. The so-called Saturn return. This happens when we are in our late 20s, then again in our late 50s. The Saturn Return is one of the most important transits in astrology, and if you are undergoing a transit of "Transiting Saturn conjunct your natal Saturn" you should pay particular attention to that part of the report.

## **Transiting Saturn in your seventh house**

This can be a time when any one-on-one relationships you have are put to the test. There could be difficulties with an existing partner, be the romantic or business. Any long standing issues in your partnered life may become extremely evident. You may be burdened with obligations and duties, and your partner may be placing all the responsibility on your shoulders. Many couples and business partners break up during this time, but if your union weathers this transit you can make sure it is for life.

Your relationships will seem quite serious at this time; there will be little time for superficial fun. Many couples get married during Saturn, because Saturn is all about standing up and taking responsibility seriously. It is therefore a very good time to commit. Marriages that happen under a Saturn transit of the 7th can be very long-lasting, functional working partnerships, although sparks and silliness may sometimes be lacking. If you are single, you may be going through a dry spell or meeting a lot potential partners that lack excitement. If you can get over this, you may find them to be extremely committed and trustworthy.

During Saturn transits of the seventh house, you will need to voluntarily give up some of your selfish ego drives for the sake of "being in a pair". It is a time for studied compromise. Try not to be too stuck on always having your way; if your love or business partner sees an alternative solution, try to be pragmatic enough to implement it.

You must make an added effort during this period to make time for your partner. You may come off cold and aloof. In business partnerships, this can add to a feeling of lack of trust and not working as a team. In romantic couples, your partner may feel shut out emotionally and unloved. It is important to make time for romance and open yourself up verbally, even though you do not feel like expressing yourself at this time. Silence will get you nowhere but alone.

If you are single, shyness and a conservative approach may keep from meeting someone. You need to make extra efforts during this time. In fact, there is probably little chance of meeting someone spontaneously. Instead, create a business plan of love to strategize the best way to meet potential mates. If you really work hard at it, and approach it almost as you would your job, you have a really good chance of meeting a longterm partner. It's a time when rationality triumphs over giddy romance.

Saturn takes about two years to transit a house and can really solidify your one-on-one relationship bonds, if you are willing to work at them and not shirk your duties to others. Partners that are superficial will be flushed away and not survive this period.

## **The meaning of the transiting Uranus**

Uranus is the planet of change, surprise and spontaneity. When it is making a harmonious aspect to your birthchart you can feel as if life is filled with excitement and limitless possibilities; you may have sudden strokes of great luck and your world could be filled with colourful and interesting individuals. Uranus is positively electric and you can feel this electricity in the air around you. The world becomes a technicolor place filled eccentric characters who make life fun and exhilarating. You will have a strong sense of adventure and be willing to take risks. If Uranus is in less harmonious aspect, however, you may feel like you are on an elevator that is plummeting top speed to the ground.

Whatever sector of your chart Uranus transits, will push you to express your individuality and discover new aspects of your own identity and the world. You may have a tendency towards rebellion and may want to upset the status quo as your search for integrity is more important than consensus. You will have a desire to act in a unique way. You will cut all things and behaviors that have become stagnant from your life. You will be interested in change and the new. Sometimes you may throw the baby out with the bath water, so try to become aware of the consequences before you act.

Uranus can bring a lot of instability to the sector of the chart it is transiting, as well as some erratic behaviour. It takes Uranus about 7 years to transit one house (and a bit longer than 80 years to cycle through the entire zodiac). These will therefore be mostly once-in-a-lifetime experiences. All this change can be quite confusing

and lead to feelings of anxiety and panic attacks. Uranus can stay in contact to a point in your birth chart for as long as 6-months at any given time, taking a year to a year-and-a-half to work its way totally through a particular transit. During this period, be aware that this too shall pass; sometimes just knowing the date a transit will end can bring comfort. Try also to practice meditation or yoga, and cut out unnecessary stimulants such as caffeine.

During a Uranian transit it is best to stay flexible, keep a zen attitude, go with the flow, and most importantly, expect the unexpected.

## **Transiting Uranus in your first house**

Your personality may be all over the place during this transit, which lasts for about 7 years. Uranus, the planet of change, has just passed over your Ascendant and entered the first house of your birthchart, marking the start of an 80 year cycle. This is a momentous period where you will become aware that the way you interact with the world is no longer valid. Any patterns of behaviour that you relied on, such as charm or control, in order to get your way may no longer fit the bill. A new type of you is now necessary. This is a period when your identity and the way you appear to the world will undergo massive, sudden alterations. It may seem as if you are trying on the cloak of several different personas to see which one will fit you the best.

This may be a confusing time for you as well as those around you who cannot understand who they are dealing with. It is best to approach this as a period of personal experimentation and try to stay away from making too many promises or commitments to others that you cannot keep. During this period, you may come off as unreliable, flakey, or even down right weird. You may want to express the more eccentric sides of your behaviour. This can leave you feeling liberated and free, especially if you spent a lifetime being repressed and in control. Rebellion could be a problem, as your desire to shake up the status quo and leave your mark is quite strong.

This can also be a heady time filled with much excitement. Your enthusiasm can be quite infectious, if short-lived, and you can sweep people up only to let them down when you move off to your next thing. You may get bored easily and try to tackle many things at once, only to lose focus and not follow through on anything. You may feel as if you are on a never ending roller-coaster and there may be many half-abandoned paths along the route. The best way to deal with this energy is to follow your inner-voice, express yourself and try not to make commitments to those around you.

At the end of this transit, you will finally gain your footing and have a better sense of who you are and what is really important to you.

## **The meaning of the transiting Neptune**

The effect of Neptune can be quite nebulous, causing considerable vagueness in the sector of the chart it is transiting. Neptune takes about 14 years to transit a house. During this time, this hazy feeling can be quite subtle; it's as if you just can never get a clear, objective glimpse at this area of your life. Neptune dissolves anything it touches and you may feel plagued by uncertainty and the underlying suspicion that things are wrong, but you can't put your finger on the exact cause.

Neptune is the planet of illusion and when it travels through a sector of your chart we may find ourselves drawn to experiences and people that normally would have no sway over us. When the transit is over you may look back at this period and wonder "What was I thinking?" If you have had any problems with drugs or alcohol, you should pay particular attention to challenging Neptune transits, because your desire to escape and erase your identity through any means necessary will be quite strong.

Neptune can lead to an identity crisis of sorts as it breaks down the clear boundaries of the ego. One may lose touch with one's own desires and wants. This can lead to feelings of insecurity and being lost in the woods. Unconscious fears and even paranoia may spring up, clouding one's ability to make decisions and act positively.

Neptune can open up the gateway to introspection, and the best way to work with this energy is to look inward. When Neptune is making a challenging aspect, even the most diehard people against psychology could gain a lot through therapy. It is a time when you can truly see how patterns of behaviour instilled at a young age can affect your adult life. While everything else is cloudy, this should be startlingly clear and you can make a lot of insights at this time.

When Neptune is making a harmonious transit, it will be like looking at the world through rose-tinted glasses. Things can be quite idealistic, romantic and poetic. You could live out some very sweet, artistic times under the spell of Neptune. Your generosity will be quite heightened as the boundaries between you and others are weakened and you feel part of the universal whole.

The "Transiting Neptune in square with your natal Neptune" is another of life's most important transits, happening around the age of 41. Pay particular attention to this part of the report if you are undergoing this transit.

## **Transiting Neptune in your first house**

You may slowly be losing grips with reality during Neptune's 14-year transit of your first house. Your identity may slowly lose its defined parameters until it gets to the point that others have no idea who you really are or what you stand for. You may become a virtual shadow of yourself, caught up in a dream world of desire and illusion, becoming increasingly out of touch with the reality of your situation. You may no longer have any clear idea what delineates the boundaries of your own identity or what makes you tick. You have a tendency to drown in pie-in-the-sky idealism as the world collapses around you, not becoming aware of the fact that not all is well until it is too late.

Neptune also brings with it the power to charm others and get them swept up and enmeshed in your dreams and ideals. The problem is people may not stick around for long when they wise up to the fact that there is no basis in reality to anything you are holding forth.

You may feel like you are inhabiting a dream world, and your powers of sensitivity are high. You pick up so many vibes that you become stagnant when you must make a choice. You need to be careful of trying to be all things to all people. Your own sense of self is very permeable so you have a tendency to come off as a mirror mimicking the desires of who ever you happen to be with at the time.

During this period, it is extremely important that you surround yourself with people who have known you for a long time and act as an anchor to your hot air balloon. They will serve as reference points when you are in danger of floating too far away and will help remind you who you really are. If you ever wanted to try therapy to solidly define your true self, this would be a good time to do so.

## **The meaning of the transiting Pluto**

Pluto is the granddaddy of all astrological transits. When Pluto makes contact to a point in your birthchart, it will bring about complete and total regeneration. Pluto moves very slowly, taking over 250 years to make one revolution through the entire zodiac, so over the course of a lifetime Pluto may only travel through 4 or 5 houses in one's birthchart. It can take from 10-to-25 years for Pluto to transit a house, and a transit to a birth planet will take a full 2 years for it to work itself out. Pluto transits define eras in our lives and once Pluto starts making its mark there is no going back. You will be most acutely aware of this transit and there will be no escaping the changes going on all around you. Pluto basically razes to the ground all structures in our lives that no longer serve their purpose and have us start from scratch. In a harmonious transit, this can be quite life enforcing, but in a more stressful transit things may seem quite overwhelming at times.

Pluto rules control issues and, during this time, it is important to let go and not cling too hard to concepts of power that serve no real purpose. You may have a desire to completely domineer everything around you, but this will only make things more difficult. Try to step away and see how your attempts may seem like downright bullying. Pluto also deals with anger. Even if you have been a serene individual all your life, you may develop a hair-trigger anger during a Pluto transit. Be careful not to alienate others with your browbeating behaviour. Power issues and imbalances of all kinds become high-lighted during a Pluto phase. You may also become the victim of another person's domineering ways, and rage may act as a defense mechanism to deal with their tyranny. Try not to allow yourself to get swept into another's drama and instead learn and practice techniques of non-defensive communication.

The best way to deal with this transit is to let go and detach yourself. Realise you cannot control every aspect of your life and that chaos is a natural part of creation. Pluto transits will be a time when chickens come home to roost and you realise you need to account for past behaviour where you did not treat others respectfully. Change will inevitably happen under a Pluto transit, so it is best to meet it halfway.

The effects of Pluto can seem devastating, almost violent at times. After this transit is over, you will be surprised at how you have become a completely new individual.

One Pluto transit the "Transiting Pluto square your natal Pluto" is one of the most important transits in astrology, occurring around the age of 35 and the first of the so-called mid-life transits. It's when we are forced to admit we are now adults and can no longer hide behind the excuse of youthful indiscretion. If you are undergoing this transit, pay particular attention to this section of the report.

## **Transiting Pluto in your eleventh house**

The 11th house rules how we interact with society at large, be they social groups of friends or other networks. It is also the house of our ideals, hopes and vision of the future. During Pluto's transit of this sector, you will have a heightened awareness of your place in the group and what this means to you. There may be power struggles and estrangements along the way. You may meet powerfully influential people during this time, who can greatly assist you in achieving your goals in life. At the same time, however, you have to be careful not to sell your soul to get there. During this period, you may find your sense of personal power either heightened or limited but somehow always at the whim of the group. This can lead to great frustration, and you may try to wrest back control, alienating those around you. Power struggles and arguments could come between you and your friends. You may also find yourself surrounded by others who are just out to use you. It may be difficult for you to adapt to the group dynamic at this point in time, and you may find yourself feeling alienated and abandoned amidst the throng. The groups you align yourself with will greatly change during this period, as well profoundly changing you. This may all sound quite daunting, but what is happening is a major shift that will allow you to surround yourself with a much more like-minded group of people which, in the end, is a very positive thing indeed.

Your ideals and goals may also undergo a profound alteration during this time. You may either experience a lot of increased personal power or you may have it sapped from you. You need to watch out for a creeping cynicism which may overtake you gradually. What you wish for in life may significantly alter over time, so it is best not to make too many promises. You may need to give up your own ego-driven goals for the good of the collective.

During this transit, it is best to be aware of who exactly it is you allow into your life, and what it is they want from you in return – it will be highly unlikely that there are no strings attached. You may become jaded because all your social interactions may seem more like transactions where all generosity is traded on a quid pro quo basis. Make sure you do not alienate yourself from old friends who can offer much needed advice, as can your family, who will be the one little group you can fully trust at this period.
